The Plaintiff and the Defendant submit this Agreed Order to the Franklin Circuit Court as final resolution of this Civil Action:

**RECITALS**

1. On September 10, 2010, the Board brought this action seeking injunctive relief which prohibits the Defendant from practicing interpreting in violation of KRS 309.301(1).
2. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to KRS 309.304(7).
3. The Plaintiff and Defendant negotiated this Final Agreed Order as a result of a mutual desire to settle and avoid a trial on this matter.

**TERMS**

1. The Defendant acknowledges that he practiced interpreting in violation of KRS 309.301(1).
2. The Defendant is permanently enjoined from the practice of interpreting as defined by the provisions of KRS 309.300 to KRS 309.319.
3. The Defendant may make application to the Board for licensure. If an application is submitted according the appropriate process as defined by regulation, the Defendant


acknowledges that his application will be evaluated by the Board to determine whether it meets the criteria required by KRS 309.300 to KRS 309.319 and the corresponding regulations in order to determine whether licensure is appropriate. The Defendant acknowledges that the Board may consider this action when making a determination related to licensure.

4. This Agreed Final Order shall be a Final Order of the Franklin Circuit Court. While the Defendant acknowledges that this Final Order is appealable, the Defendant agrees to waive his right to appeal from this Order to the Kentucky Court of Appeals.
5. The Board and the Defendant agree that this Agreed Order shall constitute the final resolution of this action and all issues referenced in the Complaint.
6. The Defendant acknowledges that, should the Plaintiff be required to move this Court to hold the Defendant in contempt for his failure to comply with the terms of this Order, the Defendant shall be obligated to reimburse the Board for the attorney's fees and any costs associated therewith.
